# Main Street's Royal Zaika brings back Indian food

## New partners bring Himalayan flavors from Nepal with world-class service

Folks were ecstatic to learn that the Royal Zaika Grill and Bar restaurant was open and bringing authentic Indian Cuisine with the influence of Himalayan cuisine to the place formerly known as the Royal Spice Restaurant at 219 Main Street in Front Royal.

Co-owners Gopal Sharma and Krishna Adhikari opened on September first this fall, with 'Zaika,' that means flavor.

"Business has been good and so many people have told us they're happy we're opening, returning with

Indian food," said Gopal.

One happy customer, who has loved Indian food and sampled it in for years in traditional Indian restaurants and at events, recommended the food and said, "It's the best Palak Paneer I've ever had!"

(Palak paneer is Indian cottage cheese in a spinach gravy, simmered in herbs and spices.)

"We both have a passion for cooking and wanting to serve people and see them happy," Krishna said.

And Gopal added, "If you don't have passion, I believe you can't give a very tasty meal."

He observed that since customers

find out they've opened they are frequent visitors.

"We have one man who comes in

five out of seven days every week for the food!" he noted. "Someone else

comes in and tries something different

every day, and another person made a video and put it on Tik Tok. Everybody has been supportive and wants us to grow. It's motivating."

The sparkling clean dining room is decorated with little lights all around the walls and bar, colorful walls and photos of Indian scenes, a temple, Mount Everest and flowers on tables.

When asked if he climbed Mt. Everest, Gopal said, "No, we have to walk most places around the mountains, and I'm not so keen to trek because of doing it every day during my life! Everywhere we went, we were walking and trekking anyway."

Gopal and Krishna are both from Nepal and have spent years in culinary schools and gained experience in service and hospitality in fine restaurants and on Cruise Lines.

They've studied wine and business in the U.S. and are offering traditional Indian food along with signature

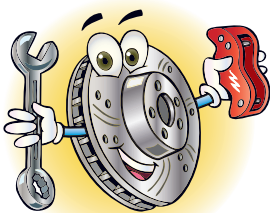

Himalayan-spiced dishes, like Momo, meat or vegetable filled steamed dumplings, which have proved to be a favorite of many local people.

“We have vegan and vegetarian options and will flavor the dishes to suit spice levels whether mild, medium or hot,” says Gopal.

Krishna, who is the chef, said right away that folks should be aware that with winter on its way, the restaurant is the place to find comfort food with their hearty lentil soup.

“We want people to know about the Momo soup from Himalayan cuisine that is good for the winter,” he said. “It’s spicy and customized, served with dumplings steaming in the soup bowl. We’ll be serving this, but it’s not on the menu. People can always ask for it and try a sample when they come in!”

Gopal told a little of their history from before they decided to open the restaurant.

“We have both worked in fine restaurants and on cruise lines, traveling all over the world, especially in Europe and the Caribbean, but we wanted a fine dining restaurant of our own,” he began. “We wanted a place to run and to show our culinary arts, also to educate people about authentic Indian and Himalayan food. It’s not fusion. We make it as authentic as possible and use the best of the best herbs and spices, routinely looking at fresh samples of these when ordering.”

Even though the partners have worked together in the food industry before, it’s their first partnership in their own restaurant.

Right now, in the first weeks, several things are just beginning to take shape. They’re working on a new menu, keeping prices in the same range, but had been waiting for delivery of the menu that had been printed last week.

They want everyone to know that for the first six months, this is a trial menu, and say they are learning from customers and welcome feedback.

So folks need to speak up and let them know what they want to see on the menu!

Changes are taking place daily, though.

“The outside sign was just painted,” noted Gopal, then added, “Everything is coming together!”

They do have a full bar, and the food is cooked to their perfectionist standards. Gopal added that he worked for five years in bars on cruise ships and has the experience necessary to fulfill that service.

As for the food, Krishna, who went to culinary school in Nepal, cooks all the main dishes.

“I do all kinds of operations, using herbs and spices according to my unique way and specialize in kebabs, which are famous in India, as well as in the middle east,” he said. “They are healthy and come sizzling from the kitchen.”

This is why “Grill” is included in their name because they cook the kebabs on an open fire, Tandoori style. (Tandoori dishes are known for their smoky flavor and are often seasoned with spices like cumin, coriander, garam masala, and turmeric)

Gopal says they assist each other when choosing herbs and spices.

“We taste them, then order.” If something is new, we try two or three companies, then decide.”

He says the meat is marinated overnight, and stresses that people should be made aware of this and called it the northwestern frontier style they specialize in.

They went on to explain that in the past, their country featuring aromatic

Himalayan cuisine was separated from others. Some shared dishes are influenced by sharing a border with China and they make Chow Mein, but the noodles have a Nepalese flavor.

Following is a partial list of the many delicious-sounding dishes on the menu.

Speaking from experience, Royal Zaika’s Masala pot of Chai Tea has the usual flavor of cardamom and cinnamon cooked with whole milk and sugar, but is so smooth and balanced that there’s no aftertaste of too much spice, as is often the case.

“They say Indian tea is all about cooking with spices and herbs-how to get the flavor when you drink it, to first experience with the nose with

smell, then taste with the tongue,” said Gopal.

Also, the fabulous mango lassi surpasses its reputation for smoothness and perfectly balanced spices.

The partners spent some time describing a few more of their dishes.

“Our desserts are very good,” said Gopal, and added, “Some people come in just for the Rice Kheer, the traditional Indian Rice Pudding.”

Mouth-watering desserts also on the menu are:

- Gulab Jamun (Fried dough balls soaked in a sweet, fragrant syrup)
- Ras malai –chunks of cottage cheese soaked in flavorful milk
- Indian ice cream
- Molten Lava Cake and more

The extensive menu includes a few dishes that they gave honorable mention, although all dishes are made with attention to detail and care, they said. Indian cooking takes time, Krishna said, with marinating giving it the right amount of time for herbs and

spices to get inside the meat.

For seafood lovers, there are various versions of shrimp and salmon.

“A hiking team came in and loved the grilled salmon tikka,” Gopal remarked, and described it as being delivered sizzling from the kitchen, served on shredded vegetables with mint chutney.

Meals come with long grain Basma-

ti rice, and they do have special lunch menus priced less than dinner, with naan (Indian fat bread) a main dish, salad, lentils, served all on one plate and choice of curry, with a vegan option available.

There are a variety of lamb, goat and chicken entrees. Some chicken dishes are served with bones cooked in the country style called Desi Murgi.

Folks enjoy the Zaika Tandoori bread special, Bombay Street food, again with many vegetarian options, Biryani, fragrant rice and protein of your choice with Indian spices and special egg dishes.

They don't have a kids' menu as such, but say that children like the non-spicy potato wedges, samosas,

# CRAFT AN EDIBLE HOLIDAY CLASSIC



- 1 1/2 tablespoons meringue powder
- 1 to 2 tablespoons warm water

To decorate:

Assorted colorful candies, sugared chocolate candies, round peppermint candies, candy canes, etc.

1. For the gingerbread: Combine the flour, cornstarch, spices, and salt in a large mixing bowl. Stir well and set aside.

2. Beat the softened butter with the molasses and vanilla in a separate mixing bowl until pale and creamy, about 2 to 3 minutes.

3. Beat in the flour mixture in 4 additions, mixing well between additions until you have a rough dough; add more flour as needed to form a stiff dough.

4. Turn out and knead briefly. Shape into a round, wrap in parchment paper, and chill for 2 hours.

5. After chilling, preheat the oven to 325 F. Grease and line 2 large baking sheets with parchment paper.

6. Remove the dough from the refrigerator. Roll out to about 0.333" thickness on a lightly floured surface.

7. Cut out two rectangles approximately 4.5" x 4" for the roof. Cut out 2 pointed rectangles approximately 5" at their tallest points and 3.5" wide at the base; these will be the front and back of the house as per the image. Make sure that one side has a round window cut out.

8. Using some of the remaining dough, cut out the 2 rectangles to be the sides of the house, approximately 3" x 4" in diameter. Use the remaining dough to cut out 4 even rectangles, approximately 2" x 1.5", to shape the chimney.

9. Arrange the pieces across the baking sheets. Bake for about 25 minutes until browned and dry to the touch. Remove to cooling racks to cool.

10. For the frosting: Combine the confectioners' sugar, meringue powder and 2 tablespoons warm water in a large mixing bowl.

11. Beat with an electric mixer until the frosting is thick and glossy, about 4 to 5 minutes; beat in more confectioners' sugar if too thin and more water if too thick.

12. Spoon into a piping bag fitted with a thin, round nozzle. Chill for 15 minutes.

13. To decorate: Using the frosting as 'glue,' assemble the chimney using the 4 even rectangles of gingerbread. Let dry and set.

14. Start to assemble the rest of the house by gluing the pieces together as per the image, attaching the front and back of the house to the sides before attaching the roof in place. Let set dry and set at each building interval.

15. Once the sections are dry, pipe more frosting onto the edges of the roof and down their sides, shaped as icicles.

16. When the chimney is set, attach it to the top, cutting the pieces to fit if necessary, and decorating the outside with frosting.

17. To decorate: Attach the assorted candies to the house, decorating the roof with a tiled pattern using the frosting.

18. Let the house dry and set until ready to serve.

Preparation time: 2 hours  
Cooling time: 2 hours, 15 minutes  
Total time: 4 hours, 15 minutes  
Difficulty: Difficult

Tips:  
Some of the gingerbread pieces will bake quicker than others depending on their size; keep an eye on them and remove from the oven when ready.

Meringue powder is available online or from specialty cookware stores.

- For the house:
- 3 1/4 cups all-purpose flour, plus extra as needed
  - 3 tablespoons cornstarch
  - 1 tablespoon ground ginger
  - 3/4 teaspoon ground cinnamon
  - 3/4 teaspoon salt
  - 1 cup unsalted butter, at room temperature
  - 3/4 cup molasses, warmed
  - 1 teaspoon vanilla extract

- For the frosting:
- 2 cups confectioners' sugar, plus extra as needed

steamed momos and chicken pakoras. And Krishna asserts, "This is one of the best places for Vegans. We have vegetarian versions also, with vegetables and paneer, onions and peppers." Soon tofu paneer, butter chicken, vegetarian Momo and samosas will be available.

They say their prices are genuine which means they are worth paying for! Another service they provide is catering and are set up to serve any number of people, with servers available and all food prepared at their restaurant. Right now, there are two parties lined up for 250 and 300 people, with one scheduled in the next month in Richmond. They stay mostly within Virginia but can go to nearby West Virginia and Maryland.

As for delivery, right now orders are delivered via Grubhub and Doordash, but after everything is set up deliveries from the restaurant in a three-mile radius are in the plans, with a smaller delivery charge. More plans include installing a grand buffet, hopefully before Thanksgiving and Christmas and enjoying their grand opening with Front Royal's mayor, the Chamber of Commerce folks and a ribbon cutting.

Gopal and Krishna are settling into the area so far, with Gopal having moved to Front Royal, but Krishna

tains out here and finds the Virginia climate similar to Katmandu, saying there are both jungles and mountains. "It feels like home here," he said. Royal Zaika Bar and Grill is located at 219 Main Street, Front Royal. The restaurant is open every day, Sunday through Thursday from 11 a.m. – 9:00 p.m. and Friday and Saturday from 11 a.m. – 9:30 p.m. Call (540) 252-2288. He is from the mountainous region in Nepal and loves seeing the moun-

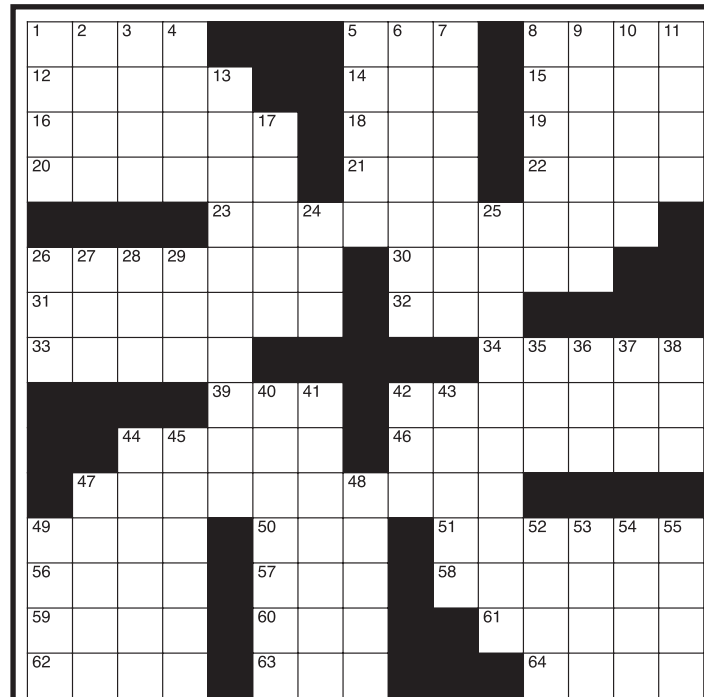

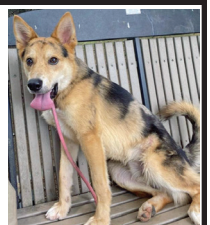

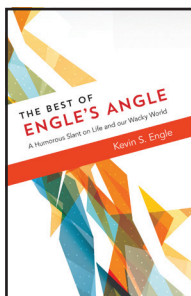

Why are there so many trees in Virginia?

- Woody

Virginia is home to a vast number of trees due to various factors such as favorable climate, historical land use, and natural resources. 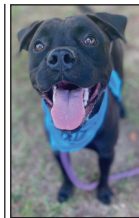

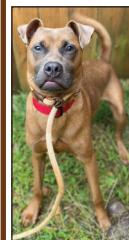

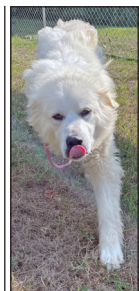
